Caribbean Days Festival Parade Rules

APPLICATION CLOSING DATE: Parade Entry & Waiver Form must be received by date indicated in the current year's Parade Entry Form and posted at <http://www.caribbeandays.ca/apply/parade-participants>

CONFIRMATION: Confirmation will be provided within two weeks of receipt of your application.

ASSEMBLY & STARTING TIME: Assembly: 9:00 AM. Commencement: 10:00 AM

ENTRANT'S APPROVAL: All entries must first be approved by the Caribbean Days Festival Parade Committee. The Parade Committee's decision regarding all entries is final.

CHECK-IN: All persons in charge of entries **MUST** report to the **CHECK-IN TABLE** which will be situated in Victoria Park North and Lonsdale Avenue no later than one-half hour before parade commencement in order to receive their allocated positions. Corresponding position numbers will be given at the **Check-in Table**;

POSITION NUMBER: The position number of every Entrant **must appear** on the lead vehicle, person, banner, etc. so that the parade judges, spectators and commentators can easily identify each Entrant.

RULES DURING PARADE:

- During the parade, entries must maintain a spacing of no less than 15 metres (approximately 50 feet) and no more than 30 metres (100 feet) behind the preceding unit and regulate their speed accordingly. **THIS IS IMPORTANT AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Caribbean Days Festival Parade Marshals will be stationed along the route and have the authority to regulate spacing and take care of any problems that may develop. Your cooperation is absolutely essential to enhance the smooth organized flow of the parade. **(Organizers reserve the right to remove Entrants who are deemed to be uncooperative.)**
- Entrants will complete the parade route by turning Left on Forbs Avenue, and will disperse at the **Railway Tracks**. Marshals will assist the Dispersal.

CHILDREN: The policies and criteria for the Youth Sections must be strictly adhered to as set out in the policy and criteria document herein.

STREET PARADE POLICIES & CRITERIA

a) Participation in the Parade:

- *All groups and individuals Must be registered with CDF 2010 by completing a Parade Entry Form by **June 15th 2010** including any entries fees applicable;*
- ***Groups must be non- political and non-religious;***
- *There will be a limit to the number of participants in a group;*
- *Each participating group should have **Two Marshals**, which would preferably be the Contact persons.*

b) Commercially sponsored groups;

- *All groups planning to enter into contracts with **sponsors**, must so advise the Parade Committee, in order that they may determine if there will be any conflict with CDF sponsors.*
- *Advertising of sponsors' banners by their parade participants must be restricted to the parade route and must terminate at the end of the parade at the **Rail Tracks** and then removed before entering Waterfront Park.*

c) Youths and Children;

- *Each individual Association is **responsible** for the Youths and Children in their respective groups.*

d) Floats;

- *Each participating group has the responsibility for safety measures around their float, and for anyone riding on it.*
